



SELECTION CRITERIA FOR QICSS TRAINING SESSIONS

Training sessions are an integral part of our research support activities. The primary objective of the training offered at the QICSS is to give current and future users the tools they need to take full advantage of the wealth of micro-data available, from census data to large-scale social and health survey and, to a lesser extent, administrative records. Training is designed for university and government researchers and graduate students (MSc and PhD), whose research and teaching depend on data analysis. Given the practical component of most training sessions, places are limited, usually at fifteen participants. Researchers, including students, already conducting projects at the QICSS thus have priority.

Using the information provided by the candidates in their application, we select participants based on two criteria: 1) the relevance of the session for the candidate's research, studies or teaching, and 2) whether the candidate has the prerequisite level of knowledge of statistical methods and/or software.
